RE: Request for Secretary's Environmental Assessment Requirements for SSD 7133– Student Accommodation at Building W1, Darling Drive Plot, Sydney International Convention, Exhibition and Entertainment Precinct (SICEEP)

I refer to your email dated 7 July 2015, seeking the Heritage Council of NSW input into the Secretary's Environmental Assessment Requirements (SEARs) for the above major project.

As delegate of the Heritage Council of NSW, I recommend that the following key issues and assessment requirements be included in the SEARs:

- Prepare a Heritage Impact Assessment (HIA) that addresses the impacts of the proposal on heritage items in the vicinity, specifically Sewage Pumping Station 1 (SHR 01336), and local heritage items and conservation areas. The HIA should include detailed mitigation measures to offset any potential impacts on heritage values.
- 2. Prepare an Aboriginal and non-Aboriginal archaeological assessment of the likely impacts and outline the proposed management and conservation measures to protect and preserve the archaeology.
- The proposed development must include interpretation of its history and significance. Interpretation should be in accordance with an Interpretation Plan for the broader SICEEP Precinct.
