- 2. Replace all references to and "Secretary" with and "Planning Secretary".
- 3. Delete the definitions for Development, and replace with:

4. Insert the following definitions in alphabetical order:

SSD 7173 MOD 3 The section 4.55(1A) modification application prepared by Willowtree Planning titled 'Section 4.55(1A) Modification Application (SSD 7173) 579 Mamre Road, Orchard Hills – Proposed Stormwater Channel Realignment and Lot 5 Expansion Works' as amended by the Response to Submissions prepared by Willowtree Planning dated 31 August 2018

In Schedule B: Administrative Conditions

- 5. Delete Condition B2 and replace with the following:
 - B2. The Applicant shall carry out the Development in accordance with the:
 - (a) EIS and RTS;

- (b) Schedule of Drawings (see Appendix 1);
- (c) SSD 7173 MOD 1;
- (d) SSD 7173 MOD 2;
- (e) SSD 7173 MOD 3; and
- (f) the Management and Mitigation Measures (see Appendix 2).

In Schedule C: Environmental Performance Conditions

- 6. Delete Condition C23 and replace with the following:
 - C23. Prior to the commencement of construction works, the Applicant shall prepare and submit a Stormwater Management Plan (SMP) to the satisfaction of the Secretary. The SMP shall form part of the OEMP required by Condition D4. The SMP shall:
 - (a) be prepared by a suitably qualified engineer prior to the commencement of the relevant works in consultation with Council;
 - (b) be updated in consultation with Penrith City Council, prior to MOD 3 works commencing;
 - (c) be prepared generally in accordance with the:
 - (i) *Civil Engineering Report*, prepared by Costin Roe Consulting, dated 31 March 2016, and accompanying drawings;
 - (ii) Civil Engineering letter prepared by Costin Roe Consulting, ref: CP12042.00-22, dated 18 June 2018, and accompanying drawings;
 - (iii) Civil Engineering letter prepared by Costin Roe Consulting, ref: CO12042.00-25, dated 29 August 2018; and
 - (iv) relevant requirements of Council and OEH
 - (d) identify all building and roadworks to be constructed relevant to the Construction Certificate to which the works relate;
 - (e) incorporate design plans and accompanying design notes, including any water sensitive urban design measures;
 - (f) describe measures which would be implemented to maintain the infrastructure during the life of the Development, including maintenance, monitoring and reporting.
- 7. Delete Condition C30 and replace with the following:
 - C30. The Applicant shall implement the Fill Importation Protocol approved under Condition C29 for the duration of bulk and detailed earthworks and drainage channel realignment works, and shall:
 - (a) keep accurate records of the volume and type of fill to be used; and
 - (b) make these records available to the Secretary upon request.
- 8. Insert Condition C56 after Condition C55, as follows:
 - C56. Prior to the commencement of drainage channel filling and/or realignment works, the Applicant must:
 - (a) prepare an archaeological testing methodology and submit to the relevant Registered Aboriginal Parties (RAPs);
 - undertake archaeological test excavations within the drainage channel realignment works area and surrounds (where the soil profile could potentially be disturbed by works) to confirm the presence of Aboriginal objects;
 - (c) prepare a test excavation report detailing the results of the test excavations, which is:
 - (i) incorporated into a revised Aboriginal Cultural Heritage Assessment Report; and
 - (ii) submitted to the RAPs for review. Comments received from the RAPs are to be included in the final test excavation report.
- 9. Insert Condition C57 after Condition C56, as follows:
 - C57. Prior to the commencement of SSD 7173 MOD 3 works, the Applicant must prepare a Vegetation Management Plan (VMP) which:
 - (a) is prepared in consultation with the Department of Industry;
 - (b) includes a fully vegetated riparian corridor consisting of a diversity of local provenance native plant species;
 - (c) includes ongoing management measures for the widths of the Vegetation Riparian Zone, in accordance with "Guidelines for Riparian Corridors" (NRAR, 2018).
