Thank you for requesting a 10 km/h shared zone on Darlington Lane, Darlington

In NSW, Roads and Maritime Services is responsible for the setting and signposting of safe and appropriate speed limits in accordance with the NSW Speed Zoning Guidelines.

Roads and Maritime has reviewed your application for a 10 km/h shared zone on Darlington Lane, Darlington.

Roads and Maritime is granting approval of the proposed shared zone conditional on the following:

- Council to confirm that a stage 4 Road Safety Audit identifying issues pertaining to vehicle speeds and pedestrian safety (including mobility and vision impaired safety) has been undertaken on Tung Hop Street and all deficiencies addressed.
- Council to confirm that a lighting audit has been undertaken to ensure appropriate lighting is considered for safety and security.
- Council to confirm that all relevant Traffic Committee approvals have been completed.
- Council to confirm that all relevant Community Consultation have been completed.
- Council to advise Roads and Maritime when all proposed works are completed.
- That and proposed parking on Darlington Lane must be within marked bays with regulatory signs.

Please respond in writing to advise your acceptance and to address the conditions of approval.

Please note that Roads and Maritime is the only delegated authority to install speed limit signs and associated road markings (including 'give way to pedestrians'), please advise Roads and Maritime, Speed Management when the engineering treatments have been installed.
