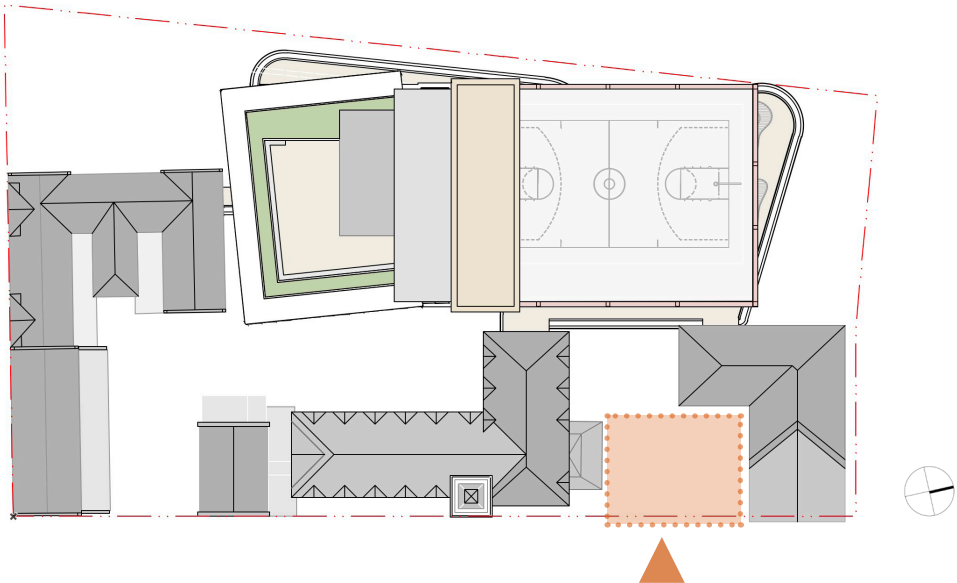

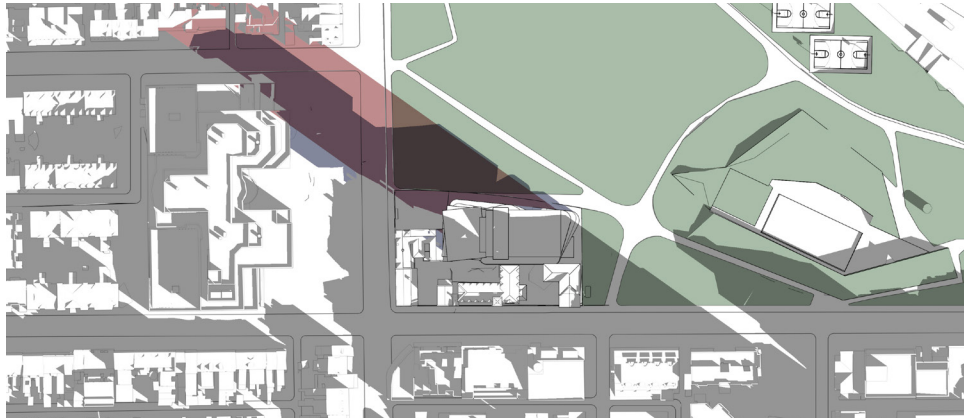


A sketch perspective view of the new Entry Forecourt

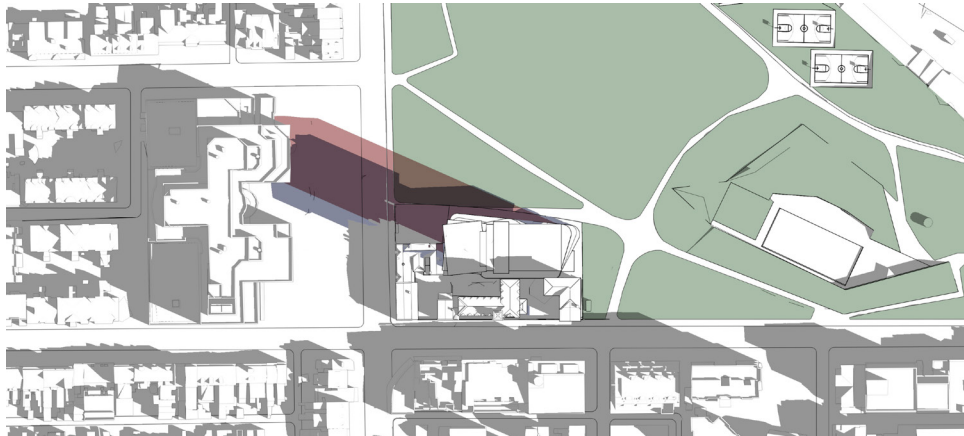
Shadow Impact Analysis

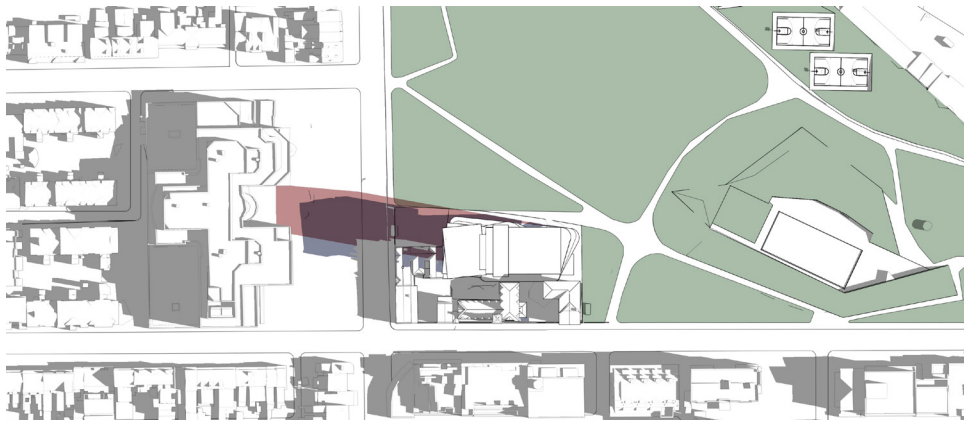
All properties affected by the overshadowing received at a minimum 4 hours of sunlight during the core hours of 9.00am - 3.00pm.



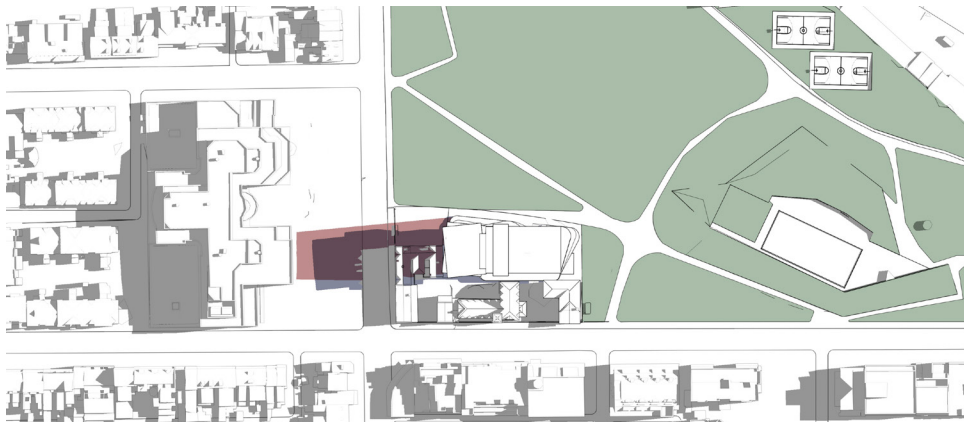

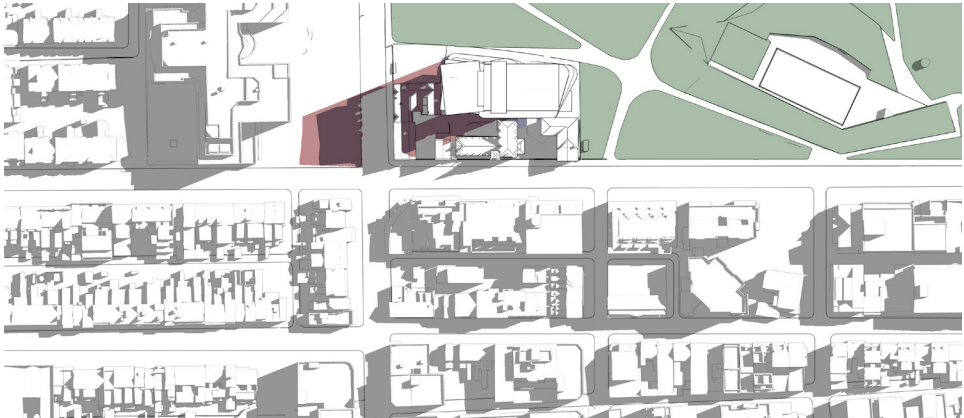

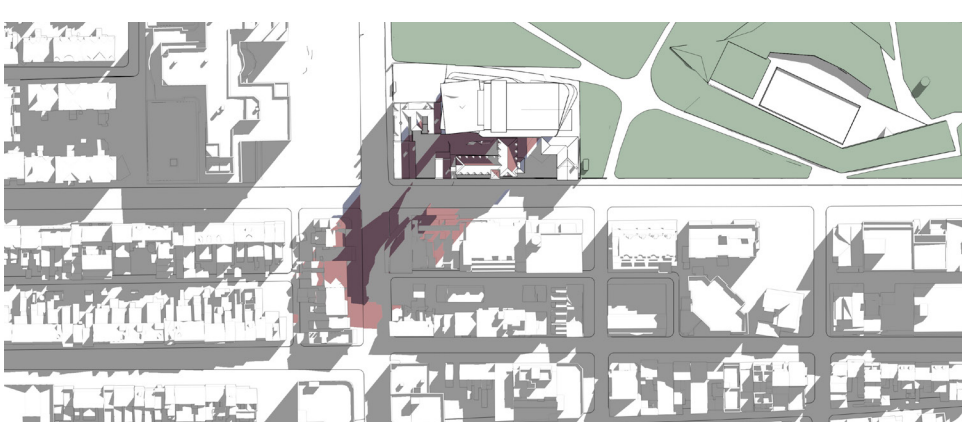
- Existing heritage fabric shadow

- Proposed shadow within Concept Report envelope



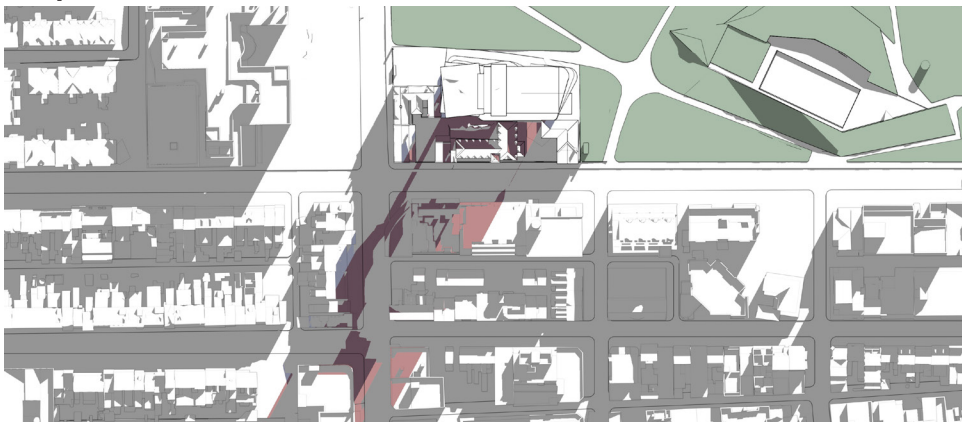

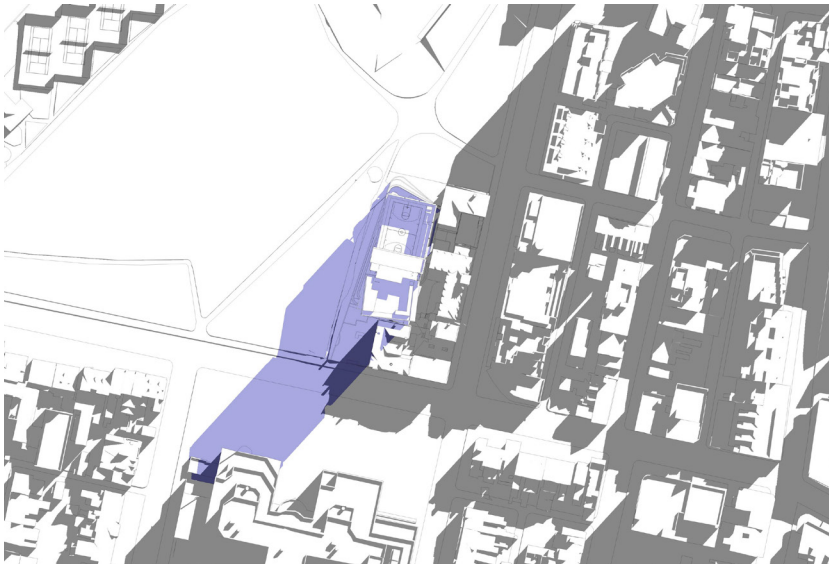

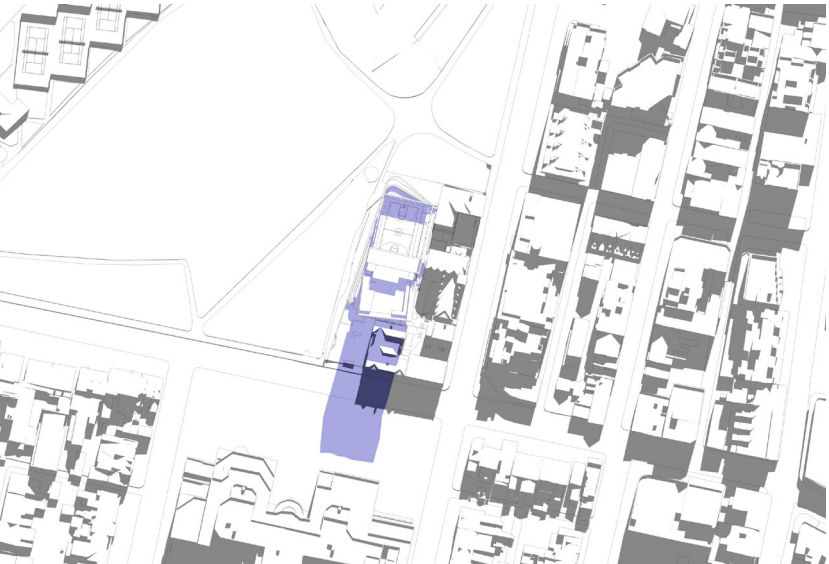
Proposed Overshadowing Study 21 June



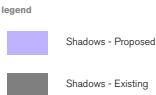
