**BLACKTOWN HOSPITAL REDEVELOPMENT STAGE 2
RESPONSE TO SUBMISSIONS**

The Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) for the Blacktown Hospital Redevelopment Stage 2 (SSD 7058) was publicly exhibited between 28 July 2016 and 26 August 2016.

In total, four agency submissions were received. Whilst none of the agency submissions raised any significant concerns regarding the proposal, comments were made around parking, noise and hours of construction. One public submission was received.
