

1. Visitor Experience (by Motherworks)

The proposed layout of the exhibits is designed to follow a linear journey, passing through five different interpretive Zones.

These Zones are:

Zone 1 – Savannah - Giraffe, Zebra and Ostrich.

Zone 2 – Kopje Country - Lions.

Zone 3 – Escarpment Village – education and site-wide views.

Zone 4 – The Waterhole – Meerkat, Fennec Fox, Okapi.

Zone 5 – The Congo - Gorillas.

Zone 1 – Savannah Giraffe, Zebra and Ostrich

A gateway introduction to Africa and all it has to offer. This zone introduces the idea of “Creators of Hope” in parallel with the stories of survival in the African Savannah. It features local villagers that dwell in this landscape and tell the stories of their specific issues and how this impacts on our key species, the Giraffe, Zebras, Okapi and Chimpanzee. There are iconic views, traditionally associated with the Giraffe and Taronga Zoo, which feature feeding programs and back of house views through to the Opera House and Sydney Harbour Bridge.
