Hi Pamela,

The proposed amendment to move to 30,000 patrons raises no direct issues, provided all relevant Key Performance Indicators have been met.

Council notes the event operates during one of the busiest times of the year for Byron Shire Council with an influx of guests and holiday makers to the Shire. It is envisaged the additional impact of a further 5000 patrons to this event will be managed as per the development consent and any other impacts (offsite and onsite) not anticipated will be reviewed and addressed following the event.

Council also notes it would be prudent to have advertised and exhibited the S4.55 Application to enable community feedback, but recognises this is a matter for the Department to consider.
