- Appendix A of this letter demonstrating satisfaction of Condition D9.

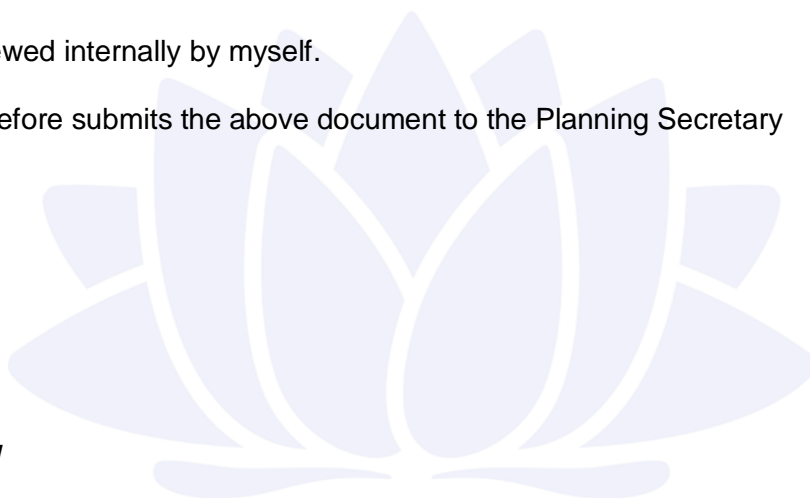

Appendix A – Condition Satisfaction Table for D9

Green Travel Plan	
D9. Prior to the commencement of operation, a Green Travel Plan (GTP), must be prepared and be submitted to the Secretary to promote the use of active and sustainable transport modes. The plan must:	
(a) be prepared by a suitably qualified traffic consultant in consultation with Council and Transport for NSW;	GTP is prepared by ARUP which are internationally recognised traffic and transport engineers/consultants. Refer to attached records of consultation for Council and TfNSW
(b) include objectives and modes share targets (i.e. Site and land use specific, measurable and achievable and timeframes for implementation) to define the direction and purpose of the GTP;	Chapter 2
(c) include specific tools and actions to help achieve the objectives and mode share targets;	Chapter 3
(d) include measures to promote and support the implementation of the plan, including financial and human resource requirements, roles and responsibilities for relevant employees involved in the implementation of the GTP; and	Chapter 3 and Section 4.1, 4.2
(e) include details regarding the methodology and monitoring/review program to measure the effectiveness of the objectives and mode share targets of the GTP, including the frequency of monitoring and the requirement for travel surveys to identify travel behaviours of students and staff to and from both schools at appropriate times throughout the academic year.
