Request for Extension to Secretary's Environmental Assessment Requirements Pick n Payless Metal Recovery and Recycling Facility, 57-69 Tattersall Road, Kings Park (SSD 8375)

I refer to your letter of 19 June 2019 seeking an extension to the Secretary's Environmental Assessment Requirements (SEARs) for the preparation of an Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) for the above State Significant Development (SSD) application.

The Department has reviewed your request and considers that the SEARs remain valid. As such, the SEARs will be extended for an additional three months. Please note that if you do not lodge an application under Section 4.12 (8) of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979 by October 2019, you must consult with the Secretary in relation to any further requirements for lodgement.
