The 'Visual impact and night lighting impact summary table' in the 'Landscape and Visual Impact Report' (AECOM 2018) identifies that the night lighting for the proposal may have a High effect on roads in the vicinity of the site. Details of this impact should be provided with measures identified to mitigate possible distraction and / or hazardous glare experienced as a result of the lighting.
