    - (b) for liquids, a minimum bund volume requirement of 110% of the volume of the largest single stored volume within the bund; and
    - (c) the Environment Protection Manual for *Authorised Officers: Bunding and Spill Management technical bulletin* (EPA, 1997).
  - B27B. In the event of an inconsistency between the requirements B27A(a) to B27A(c) the most stringent requirement must prevail to the extent of the inconsistency.




Figure 1: Site Plan
