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1 Introduction

1.1 Submission to NSW Department of Planning, Industry and Environment for Approval

This Staging Report has been prepared by Johnstaff Projects on behalf of the NSW Department of Education (DoE) for Fairvale High School (SSD 8677). The Staging Report has been prepared in accordance with the conditions of the State Significant Development Approval SSD 8677.

This Staging Report accompanies a Section 4.55(1A) modification to State Significant Development Approval SSD-8574 to allow staged construction and operation of the development. The date of submission of the report is 17 July 2020.

1.2 Project Overview

The NSW Government is investing \$6.7 billion over the next four years to deliver more than 190 new and upgraded schools to support communities across NSW. In addition, a record \$1.3 billion is being spent on school maintenance over five years. This is the largest investment in public education infrastructure in the history of NSW.

The Fairvale High School redevelopment project aims to replace existing demountables with 30 new teaching spaces accommodating up to 600 students. This will produce a net gain of 10 teaching spaces taking the total capacity up to 1,560 students, which represents an increase of 200 students. The project will also upgrade the core facilities to 9 stream standard, remove and replace the bini dome structure with a gym. The scope of work developed comprised the following proposed works:

- New covered outdoor learning area (COLA)
- 30 new permanent teaching spaces (Block K) and removal of 18 demountable teaching spaces
- Upgrade of administration facilities (Block A)
- New multi-purpose hall and gymnasium (Block J)
- Demolition of Bini Dome

1.2.1 Date of Construction Commencement

Construction commenced in March 2020.

1.2.2 Submission to Planning Secretary for Approval.

This Staging Report accompanies a Section 4.55(1A) modification to State Significant Development Approval SSD-8677 to allow staged construction and operation of the development.

The date of submission of the report is 17 July 2020.

1.3 Details of Proposed Staging

1.3.1 Staging

The SSD pertains to the delivery of the entire package of works. To maintain operational continuity throughout construction the works and as a result of site access restrictions the works must be staged. An indicative five stage approach is proposed as follows:

- Stage 1 is the construction and handover of the COLA.
- Stage 2 is the construction and handover of the new academic building (Block K)
- Stage 3 is the construction and handover of the new multi-purpose hall and gymnasium (Block J)
- Stage 4 is the upgrade of administration facilities (Block A)
- Stage 5 is the removal of 18 demountable teaching spaces and demolition of the Bini Dome plus landscaping

Stage 1

Construction and handover of the COLA	4 months		

The construction and demolition of the COLA will take approximately 4 months. The new COLA is being provided as a replacement for the existing COLA that will be demolished to make way for Block J. Stage 1 works have been selected to provide the school with the new play area as a priority as the school will experience significant restrictions in available play space and as such have requested these works be completed first. As such, the new COLA has to be handed over prior to Block J works commencing so the school can maintain operational continuity.

The construction of Stage 1 and the subsequent stages are distinct with no overlap in the delivery. Stage 1 will be completed in its entirety prior to Stage 3 commencing.

Stage 2

Construction and handover of new 3 Storey Building Block K	15 months

Stage 2 is to commence at the same time as Stage 1 and run concurrently with it. Block K includes new administration facilities and will become the new entrance for the school. As such, the existing Block A services will be transferred to Block K once complete. This means though, that Stage 4 works comprising the refurbishment of Block A cannot commence until Stage 2 is completed so the school can maintain operational continuity.

Stage 2 will be completed in its entirety prior to Stage 4 commencing.

Stage 3

Construction of new Multi-purpose Hall Block J	12 months		

Stage 3 can only commence once the new COLA and relocation of the shade sail in Stage 1 is completed. Further to this, as the new Multi-purpose Hall is a replacement for the bini-dome, the demolition of the bini-dome in Stage 5 cannot commence until Stage 3 is completed.

Stage 3 will be completed in its entirety prior to Stage 5 commencing.




Figure 3 Stage 3 Delineation




Figure 4 Stage 4 Delineation




Figure 5 Stage 5 Delineation
