The above consent is modified as follows:

(a) Schedule 2 Part A – Conditions A21, A22, A23, A24, A25 are inserted using **bold and <u>underlined</u>** words as follows:

Staging

- A21. The project may be constructed and operated in stages in accordance with the Staging Report Greystanes Public School SSD 8778 Version 03 prepared by Daniel Smith on behalf of NSW Department of Education in August 2020.
- A22. Staging of the proposed development may be varied (for either construction or operation) in accordance with a revised Staging Report submitted to and approved by the Planning Secretary.
- A23. Any revised Staging Report prepared in accordance with condition A22 must:
 - (a) if staged construction is proposed, set out how the construction of the whole of the project will be staged, including details of work and other activities to be carried out in each stage and the general timing of when construction of each stage will commence and finish;
 - (b) if staged operation is proposed, set out how the operation of the whole of the project will be staged, including details of work and other activities to be carried out in each stage and the general timing of when operation of each stage will commence and finish (if relevant);
 - (c) specify how compliance with conditions will be achieved across and between each of the stages of the project; and
 - (d) set out mechanisms for managing any cumulative impacts arising from the proposed staging.
- A24. The project must be staged in accordance with the Staging Report approved under condition A21 or in accordance with a revised Staging Report approved under condition A22.
- A25. The terms of this approval that apply or are relevant to the works or activities to be carried out in a specific stage set out in the Staging Report as approved under condition A21 or a revised Staging Report approved under condition A22, must be complied with at the relevant time for that stage.
