I am writing to request approval for out of hours works required to be undertaken on the Cranbrook School Redevelopment project

The works involve the removal of multiple trees at the northern boundary of Cranbrook School along the verge of Rose Bay Avenue and New South Head Rd (Refer CR-A05-002[5] Demolition Plan attached). As some of the trees overhang New South Head Rd one lane of traffic on New South Head Rd must be closed to allow the trees to be removed safely. The ROL and lane closure has been approved by RMS however restricts the works to be undertaken at night (please see ROL attached for approved hours)

The trees will be lopped with chainsaws at night however mulching of the trees will be postponed and completed during DA hours to minimise the noise impact at night.
