RE: Major Alterations and Additions to the Stevenson Library Building, Scots College 29-53 Victoria Road, Bellevue Hill (SSD-8922) Response to Submissions

Thank you for your invitation dated 11 January 2019 to comment on the Response to Submissions (RtS) Report for State Significant Development SSD 8922 for Major alterations and additions to the Stevenson Library Building at the Scots College, which is not listed on the State Heritage Register.

The letter response to heritage maters, prepared by John Oultram Heritage & Design dated 5 November 2018 and the response prepared by JCA architects dated 8 November 2019 incorporates detailed discussions and clarifications to address the issues raised in the Heritage Division submission dated 3 October 2018, during the public exhibition of the Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) for SSD 8922.

The issues addressed relate to the roof form of the proposed library building and the recommended condition of approval: "The roof design shall be simplified to avoid visual competition with the Aspinal House". The response to submissions reports has been reviewed and it is noted that the issues have been adequately clarified and addressed. Therefore, this recommended condition of approval can be disregarded. All other recommended conditions remain and no further comments are provided.
