Further to our correspondence regarding SSDA Modification 3, Multiplex and INSW has identified a requirement for a further modification to the SSDA due to the change in the basement design detailed in Modification 3 and the results of a bathymetric survey that has been undertaken following the demolition of the existing wharf structures. This further modification, Modification 4, seeks approval for INSW to redistribute material to level the seabed to facilitate the construction of the new Sydney Fish Market. Further details regarding the extent and methodology of the reprofiling are contained in the Modification Report. The report and supporting documentation is contained in the attached zip file.

3XN has reviewed the proposed modification and provided its opinion that the proposed modification will have no

impact on the design intent of the approved development, as per the attached Design Statement.
