SCHOOL OPERATION

The school commences around 8:30 and is busiest just before 9am.

All rooms in Block A, B, C, D, F, Dem 10325 and L are homebases and are currently housing classes. Block G is the library and is used throughout the week by classes.

Block H is the hall and is used by community users (after hours) who have contracts with the school. These include Karate, drama, choir and church groups.

Block E (OSHC) is being used during the day by the school for Scripture and cooking sessions, however this is the OOSH Room, not a classroom.

OSHC

The After School Care is provided from 3:15 to 6pm in Block E with enrolment of 60 children at full capacity. There is a waiting list for after school care. There is no Before school care provided.

EMERGENCY ACCESS

Access for Firebrigade and ambulance is via France Street.


DELIVERIES

Deliveries are usually via Frances Street. Delivery personel sometimes calls the school ahead of time or will signal in France Street for access. The Canteen delivery happens via Frances Street and the times are coordinated with the school. School deliveries are often brought through the pedestrian gate on France Street or delivery personel comes in to ask for gates to be unlocked, depending on the type of delivery.

WASTE COLLECTION

The collection process happens through the double gates on France Street where the bins are positioned.

There are issues with waste collection, due to time and the noise made. The school has unsuccessfully tried to rectify the problem with the waste collection company.



The school site has CCTV survailance installed and are monitored form Block L (BER building)


FENCE AND GATES

The gates open in the morning between 8am and


9am and in the afternoon between 2:30 and 3:30 pm.
