The Project is located within the Port Stephens LGA. Under the provisions of the Port Stephens Local Environmental Plan 2013 (Port Stephens LEP), the majority of the site is zoned RU2 – Rural Landscape. Extractive industries are permissible in this zone with consent. The portion of Crown land at the entrance to the site is zoned RE1 - Public Recreation, in which extractive industry is prohibited. No extractive activities are currently undertaken or are proposed on Crown land.
