Request for Biodiversity Development Assessment Report Waiver for SSD 9772 - Santa Sophia Catholic College - Corner Red Gables Road & Fontana Drive, Box Hill North

Dear Mr Hay

The Office of Environment and Heritage (OEH) has reviewed the request from Urbis dated 20 March 2019 submitted on 21 March 2019 to waive the requirement for a Biodiversity Development Assessment Report (BDAR) to be submitted with the above State Significant Development Application.

Under section 7.9(2) of the *Biodiversity Conservation (BC) Act 2016*:

"Any such application [SSD] is to be accompanied by a biodiversity development assessment report unless the Planning Agency Head and the Environment Agency Head determine that the proposed development is not likely to have any significant impact on biodiversity values".

The power to determine whether an SSD is "not likely to have any significant impact on biodiversity values" has been delegated to the OEH Senior Executive on 4 December 2017.

I have reviewed the assessment of the biodiversity values of the site as described in the documentation submitted on 21 March 2019. I have determined that the proposed development is not likely to have any significant impact on biodiversity values and that there is no need for the SSD application to include a BDAR.
