

## Determination under clause 7.9(2) of the Biodiversity Conservation Act 2016

I, Glenn Snow, Director (Transport Assessments), of the Department of Planning, Industry and Environment, under clause 7.9(2) of the *Biodiversity Conservation Act 2016*, determine that SSI-19238057 Sydney Metro West- The Bays to Sydney CBD (the proposed development) is not likely to have any significant impact on biodiversity values and therefore a Biodiversity Development Assessment Report is not required.

Proposed development means major civil construction work between The Bays and Sydney CBD including:

- Enabling works such as demolition, utility supply to construction sites, utility adjustments, and modifications to the existing transport network
- Tunnel excavation including tunnel support activities
- Station excavation for new metro station at Pyrmont and the Sydney CBD.

If the proposed development changes so that it is no longer consistent with this description, a further waiver request is required.

If you do not lodge the infrastructure application related to this determination for the proposed development within **2 years** of the issue date of this determination, you must either prepare a BDAR or lodge a new request to have the BDAR requirement waived.
