- (3) Permissibility and Strategic Planning: Identify the strategic planning documents, environmental planning instruments and key development standards applying to the infrastructure, including any development standards not being met.
- (4) Preliminary environmental impact assessment; Identify and prioritise the expected environmental impacts (positive and negative) associated with the infrastructure, based on a preliminary risk assessment. Briefly outline any strategies to address the impacts identified.
- (5) Justification: Explain why the site was chosen for the proposal and briefly discuss the alternatives considered. Outline the strategic context for the proposal, including the benefits to the region and/or State.
- (6) <u>Consultation</u>: Outline any consultation (with the community, local councils, other Government agencies) already undertaken and proposed to be carried out for the proposal.
- (7) <u>Capital investment value</u>: Provide an accurate estimate of the cost of carrying out the proposal. If your proposal is identified as State significant by a capital investment value threshold in Schedule 3 of the SRD SEPP, a quantity surveyor's report confirming the capital investment value of the infrastructure is required.
