Notice of Exhibition: Barangaroo Ferry Hub / Barangaroo Ferry Terminal (SSI 6727)

The following submission is in reference to the State Significant Infrastructure (SSI) application and Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) submitted by Transport for NSW for the construction and operation of three wharves at Barangaroo.

In accordance with the Barangaroo Delivery Authority Act 2009, it is the responsibility of the Authority to create in Barangaroo an opportunity for design excellence outcomes in architecture and public domain design.

The Authority supports the introduction of ferry services at Barangaroo. In doing so the Authority is obligated to ensure the integration and coordination of the Ferry Hub with the design and treatment of the landside Waterfront Promenade area.

The EIS includes a number of landside matters that are yet to be resolved and which will require ongoing consultation with, and approval from the BDA before they are finalized as they impact the proposed public domain on Barangaroo. These include (but are not limited to):

- Design of all elements that interface with the promenade such as handrails, finishes and any adjustments to the proposed Stage1A Public Domain.
- Design and location of wayfinding signage;
- Design and location of ticket machines;
- Service access arrangements;
- Special event management, including pedestrian circulation and queue management;
- Interface with heat rejection system;
- Location and design of bicycle racks;
- Emergency access and congregation points;
- Location and extent of temporary construction compound;

The Authority recommends that a condition of consent be imposed requiring Transport for NSW to consult with, and obtain approval from the Barangaroo Delivery Authority, for all items which impact on any landside elements as a result of the development of the Ferry Hub.
