Sydney Gateway Road Project (SSI 9737) Local Road Request – Condition E52

I refer to the document titled 'Sydney Gateway – E52 Approval to use local roads' submitted to the Department on 26th March 2021 in accordance with Conditions E52 and E53 of the Sydney Gateway Road Project (SSI 9737).

I note that:

- you have advised that consultation with Peek-A-Boo childcare centre and Inner West Council regarding the use of roads has occurred;
- a swept path analysis was conducted which demonstrates a 19 m semi-trailer plus Truck and Dog can safely navigate turns onto the proposed roads;
- the local roads are in an existing industrial area; therefore, the project will have minimal amenity impacts on residents along the local roads;
- Transport for NSW has reviewed the documents and raises no concerns; and
- you will implement measures to manage the potential road user and pedestrian impacts and these will be implemented for the duration of the works.

Accordingly, as a nominee of the Planning Secretary I approve the use of local roads with the associated limitation as described in Table 1 attached. Please ensure that the approved roads are included in the construction Traffic Transport and Access Management Plan.
