


#### **ISSUE:**


The Naremburn residential area (NCA32.1) located <u>less than 200m</u> <u>from the major construction zone</u> has not been considered at all for at-property treatment.

#### **ASK:**

That the Naremburn residential area (NCA32.1) be made eligible for at-property noise reduction treatment



## From Chapter 10 of the EIS



#### **ISSUE:**

High noise activities are planned to be from 10:30pm to midnight

This will severely impact the ability for families to commence sleep each night resulting in sleep deprivation, a key contributor to mental health issues

#### **ASK:**

Any high-noise activity be completed during daylight hours
