Thanks for reaching out and mentioning these issues. I do remember the discussion about making the project more searchable and in response we added the below to the description on our project page:

"The Project is located in NSW about 10 km east of Muswellbrook and 185 km north of Sydney across three council boundaries. Wind turbines will be primarily located in the Muswellbrook Shire and Singleton Councils, with a small number of turbines proposed in the Upper Hunter Shire Council. There are a number of rural communities in proximity to the proposed wind farm including: Hebden, Muscle Creek, McCully's Gap, Rouchel Brook, Bowmans Creek and Goorangoola."

After reading your email I typed in 'Muscle Creek Wind Farm' and our project page came up first but I will acknowledge that this may be impacted by my search history (I won't pretend to understand how google's algorithm works).
