1. Heritage impacts on 50 Phillip Street

I am not opposed to the conservation and adaptive reuse of the former Public Works building at 50 Phillip Street but the way the proposed tower cantilevers over 50 Phillip Street is inappropriate and badly detracts from and diminishes its heritage significance. I urge the Department to refuse the application. 2. Place of Employment.
