I refer to the Department's below email of 6 May 2021 regarding the request for State Significant Development SSD-8865-Mod-1 St Anthony of Padua Catholic School Redevelopment for proposed amendments to project staging, site layout, the composition of outdoor and indoor recreational facilities, building bulk and scale including a reduction in total gross floor area, and minor changes to drop-off / pick-up area at 125-165 Tenth Avenue and 140-170 Eleventh Avenue, Austral (Lots 810, 811, 812, 840, 841, 842 DP 2475; Lots 1 & 2 DP 1232692). Submissions need to be made to the Department by 24 May 2021.

Please refer to Endeavour Energy's submission made to the Department via email on 10 February 2020 in relation to State Significant Development Application (SSD 8865) - Redevelopment of St Anthony of Padua School at 125-165 Tenth Avenue and 140-170 Eleventh Avenue, Austral (Lots 810, 811, 812, 840, 841, 842 DP 2475; Lots 1 & 2 DP 1232692). Endeavour Energy has noted from the Section 4.55(2) Modification Report the proposed amendments do not appear to have a direct or significant impact on the existing or required electricity infrastructure. Notwithstanding the proposed amendments the recommendations and comments provided therein essentially remain valid.

Subject to the foregoing and the following further recommendations and comments Endeavour Energy has no objection to the Development Application.

- Network Capacity / Connection

The applicant will need to contact Endeavour Energy's Network Connections Branch (via Head Office enquiries on business days from 9am - 4:30pm on telephone: 133 718 or (02) 9853 6666) who is responsible for managing the conditions of supply with the proponent and their Accredited Service Provider (ASP). However the applicant will need to contact Endeavour Energy's Network Connections if this Development Application:

- Includes any contestable works projects that are outside of any existing approved / certified works.
- Results in an electricity load that is outside of any existing Supply / Connection Offer requiring the incorporation of the additional load for consideration. This is due to load being based on a desktop assessment. Depending on the actual development proposed for the site, the load provided may not be sufficient.

Should you wish to discuss this matter, or have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact me or the contacts identified above or in Endeavour Energy's previous submission in relation to the various matters. Due to the high number of development application / planning proposal notifications submitted to Endeavour Energy, to ensure a response contact by email to property.development@endeavourenergy.com.au is preferred.

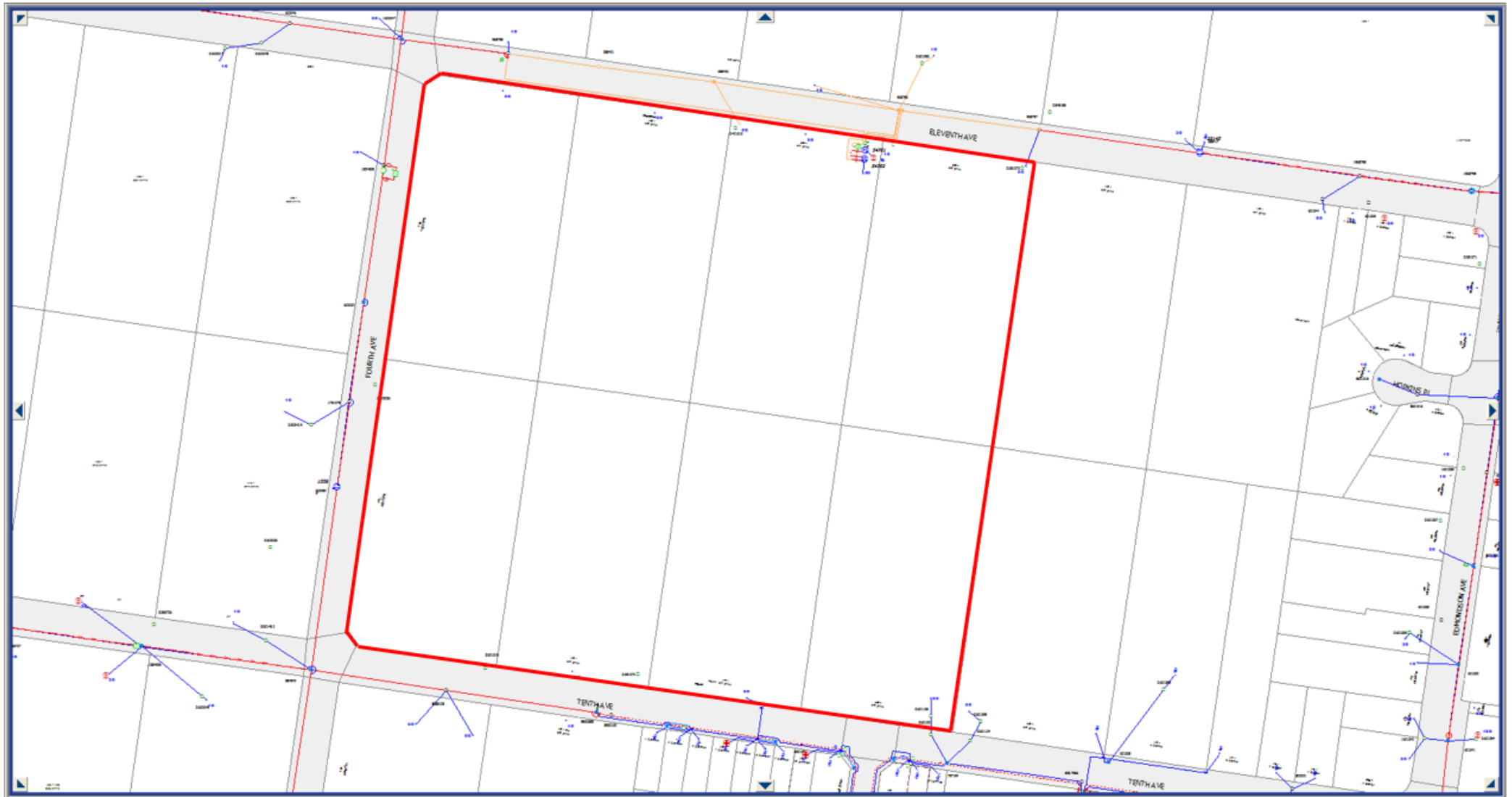

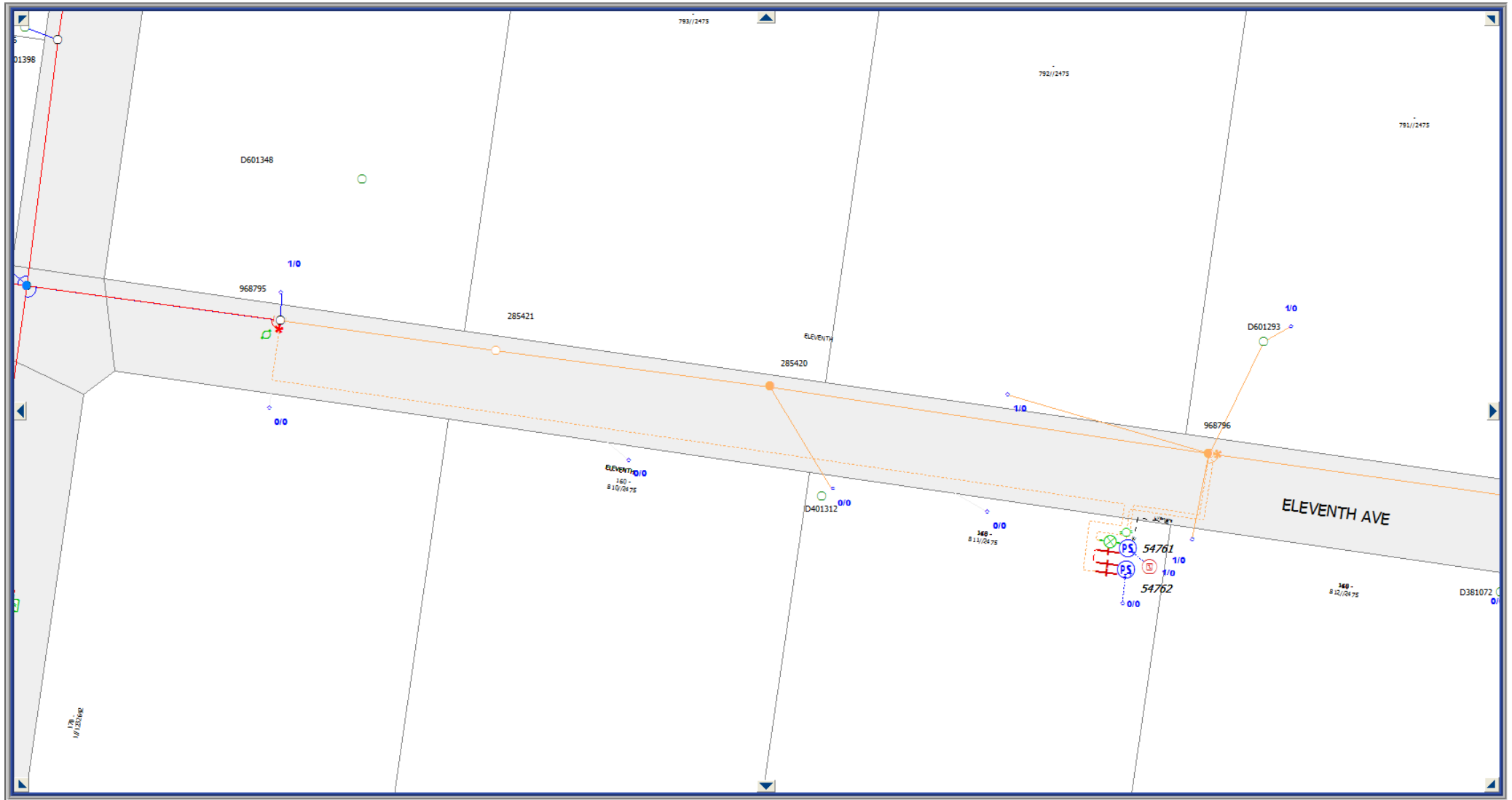
