My name is Kim Eglin and I am the Managing Director of KE Solutions Group Pty Ltd, one of the key consulting offices for the underground coal industry. Over the past 20 years, we have been involved in a number of green field sites such as Malabar Coal's Maxwell Underground Project, and fully support the project proceeding.

The NSW coal industry has been subjected to many adverse impacts in recent years and seen a decline in jobs and growth with a number of Mine underground mine closures.
