Dear Sir/Madam,

I am writing to object to the planned flyover as it is presented in the online documents. I am hostile to the whole concept of WestConnex, the reprehensible waste of public money it represents, and the benefit it confers to a private operator.

The whole WestConnex project is predicated on easing congestion while at the same time inducing demand. This is a conflict of design and application. Any attempt to improve traffic flow should begin with reducing vehicle usage in the area well before any resort to monumental structures that disfigure the landscape. I do realise some in government especially have a penchant for modern brutalist concrete blots on the environment.

Concrete is responsible for 6 – 8 % of the global greenhouse gas emissions. Motor transport for roughly 30% of Australian greenhouse gas emissions. The facts on the table regarding emissions and the Paris climate targets. I could cite policy targets, if I could find the appropriate documents in the labrynthine enclave of government, but it is obvious the Liberal and Labor Party and Bureaucrats ignore those policies at will.

I use a bicycle as my day to day transport. I hold a motor vehicle licence but do not own a car. I use public transport. As a person on a bicycle I often refer to the planning criteria of the CROW manual, followed by the Netherlands and others regarding bicycle infrastructure. Freeways and tollways in the inner city will be the 21st century equivalent of 19th century coal fired power plants.

Please abandon this insane planned flyover. Plant more trees, revive more wetlands and blue carbon, create a playground and parklands that invite people to abandon their cars in favour of walking, cycling and public transport. Impose a congestion tax on vehicles within a 10km radius of the CBD. Your children and your children's children will thank you for it – if we all live that long.
