WesTrac NSW would like to register their support for the McPhillamy Gold Project (SSD-9505).

When approved this project will create a positive mining environment in the local region. The estimated of 788 direct and indirect jobs created during full operation, will contribute both a direct economic benefit and a less measurable social benefit to the local communities in the adjoining local government areas.

The estimated \$150M in royalties and company taxes will benefit the state and federal governments and provide funds for vital government projects. This is an additional \$202M in residual producer surplus.

WesTrac are the Caterpillar dealer for NSW and the ACT, and we directly employ over 1300 people in NSW, of whom approximately 1150 are employed outside the Sydney metropolitan area.
