Jemena Eastern Gas Pipeline (**Jemena**) has reviewed and assessed the Environmental Impact Statement referenced above. Jemena has given consideration to the potential safety risk and impacts to and from the Jemena gas pipelines located within proximity of the proposed development.

Jemena requests the following information to undertake an appropriately thorough assessment of the environmental impact statement:

- The applicant is to provide details around the proposed crossing of the Eastern Gas Pipeline in the Picton Road alignment, for works associated with the temporary construction carpark and increased construction traffic, including vehicle types and volumes; and
- The applicant is to confirm that the proposed mine extension will not result in any subsidence along the Eastern Gas Pipeline alignment. If the applicant is not able to confirm, Jemena requests that the applicant engage an appropriately qualified independent consultant to assess the impact.

It is noted that the Eastern Gas Pipeline has been affected by subsidence from the Dendrobium Mine in the past, and costly remedial actions have been necessary to avoid damage to Jemena's assets.
