Submission on Northside Private Hospital, West Gosford Application No SSD-10159

Dear Sir/Madam

This submission is presented on behalf of Friends of Gosford Pty Ltd. We thank you for the opportunity to present a submission on the Northside Private Hospital, West Gosford Application No SSD-10159. In respect to this application we wish to make the following comments.

We understand this application has been made under *State Environmental Planning Policy (Gosford City Centre) 2018* (SEPP GCC). As noted on page 9 of the Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) prepared by Willow Tree Planning dated September 2019 the proposed development <u>significantly exceeds the height and floor space ratio (FSR) controls</u> allowable for the under SEPP GCC.

We appreciate that in accordance with Clause 8.4(4) of SEPP GCC that a consent authority can vary the building height and FSR subject to specific criteria. However, the criteria are limited to site area, building design supported by the design review panel, building sustainability and environmental performance.

As the assessment criteria for allowing significant variations to height and FSR is limited we request the Department of Planning judiciously evaluate the proposal in accordance with sections 4.15(1)(b) and 4.15(1)(e) of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*. Our rational for making this request is because the limited criteria for varying building height and FSR does not address the local build environment and the public interest.

Of particular concern relating to the built environment is the location and scale of the proposed development in such close proximity to large traffic generating activities of Gosford Railway Station, Gosford Hospital, Gosford High School, Henry Kendal High School, Gosford Primary School and Gosford Racecourse. This has multiple implications.

The first implication is the number of traffic generating activities impacting traffic along Racecourse Road and the railway bridge at Etna Street. We believe the traffic report has a significant oversight in that it only identified three (3) key intersections of the Central Coast Highway with Racecourse Road,

Racecourse Road with Faunce Street West and Faunce Street West with Showground Road. In our opinion the most significant intersections with traffic implications are the intersection of Racecourse Road with Showground Road, Etna Street Railway Bridge and the intersection of Mann Street with Etna Street which are illustrated in the accompanying aerial photo.



Personal experience of attempting to travel along Racecourse Road from the Central Coast Highway to Etna Street railway bridge has resulted in extensive delays. Reviewing both the EIS and the Traffic Assessment Report these documents have not addressed the current traffic delays and the implications of the proposed private hospital.

Please note in our opinion the traffic movement across Etna Street railway bridge is a matter of significant public interest. Until the consent authority has a full understanding of the implications of traffic movement along the full length of Racecourse Road and Etna Street, we believe the determination of this application should be deferred.

If deferring the application, we suggest the Department of Planning request the applicant consider the implications on traffic movement along Racecourse Road and Etna Street. If the Department were to request clarification from the applicant on this oversight, we would request that the applicant be requested to consider the traffic implications if the State Government were to consider an alternative east west/north south road bypass around the Gosford City Centre.

A proposed east west / north south road bypass around the Gosford City Centre is presented in Appendix A.

The second implication is the concern of the number of carparking spaces provided on-sight. It is noted the applicant has used the car parking provisions for private hospitals specified in the Roads and Maritime Services Guide to Traffic Generating Developments (2002) (RMS GTGD). A copy of page 3-21 of the RMS GTGC is provided below.

It is recommended that the models based on the number of beds (B) should only be used when staffing data is unknown.

#### **Factors**

The hospitals surveyed had between 30 - 99 beds (B), and between 10 - 102 average staff per weekday day shift (ASDS).

The mean proportion of people who travelled to the site by vehicle was 87.4%, with a range of 67.3% - 98.2%. Average vehicle occupancy was found to be 1.3 persons per car.

Reviewing the above text, it is noted that the formula to calculate the number of car parking spaces is based upon a survey of between 30 – 99 bed private hospitals. As the proposed development has 224 beds which is 2.26 times greater in size than the 99 beds surveyed does this mean that more car parking is required?

Additional it is noted on page 79 of Council's Draft Urban Spatial Plan – Framework for a Local Strategic Planning Statement copied below that due to the dispersed pattern of urban development there is currently not an *efficient or effective public transport network*. As there is not an *efficient or effective public transport network* it is anticipated the majority of people travelling to the proposed development would use private vehicles.



Given the size of the proposed development and the fact there is not an *efficient and effective public transport network* on the Central Coast we request the Department of Planning seek an appropriated independent expert to advice on what formula should be applied to calculate the number of car parking spaces to be provided. We suggest the 50 additional carparking spaces proposed by the applicant which represents a 10% increase above the RMS GTGD may not be adequate.

The third implication relates to public transport. It is noted on page 8 of Appendix 9 of the Traffic Impact Assessment it states: "the development benefits from good bus services...". It then lists 5 bus routes that provide service to the development. However, when you examine the bus route timetables presented in Appendix B Bus Routes 20, 32 32/4 and 33/4 only provide limited connections to the site. Where therefore hold the view that the site does not benefit from a good bus service rather it is connected by a staggered bus service. As the site is not connected to good bus service, we recommend that if the Department were to approve the development than as a condition of consent require the provision of a free shuttle bus service between the development and Gosford Railway Station Bus terminal.

### **Appendix A**




Fig 1 - Proposed east west /north south road bypass around the Gosford City Centre

Proposed east west/north south bypass around Gosford City Centre. The proposed route is presented in Figure 1.

The proposed route has the following advantages:

- A. The route commences at West Gosford therefore there is no requirement to construct an alternative access from the M1 Motor Way down the escarpment which was an earlier consideration of Council.
- B. The road grade along the entire route is level except for a slight grade variation in the central section of Glennie Street. This slight grade variation is not significant at the grade changes in elevation approximately 10 metres over a distance of approximately 200 metres.




Fig 2 Proposed upgrading of the Narara to Lisarow

- C. The proposed east / west bypass can be linked to the north / south upgrade of the Old Pacific Highway. By examining the RMS website indicates the State Government is planning the upgrade of the Narara to Lisarow Pacific Highway and Manns Road upgrade between Narara Creek to Parsons Road consisting of the Northern section and Southern section illustrated in Fig 2.





Fig 3 - Alternative route to Manns Road and Old Pacific Highway

Rather than constructing the Southern section colour coded blue in Fig 2 it is suggested the Northern section colour coded green should follow the existing Old Pacific Highway to the intersection of Glennie Street colour coded purple in Fig 3.

#### This alternative route has the benefit of:

- 1. A major section of the Old Pacific Highway is already four lanes.
- 2. Relocating a proposed new railway bridge at the intersection of Manns Road with the Old Pacific Highway to the intersection of Glennie Street. Due to the proximity of Glennie Street to Etna Street the relocation of the railway bridge crossing to Glennie Street should avoid the need to expand the railway bridge crossing at Etna Street.
- 3. Constructing one new bridge over Narara Creek at the western end of Glennie Street west avoids the requirement to construct two new bridges over Narara Creek and its associated tributaries on Manns Road.
- 4. Avoids the residential section of Narara which fronts Manns Road
- 5. Widening the western end of Glennie Street west is adjacent to the Gosford Show Ground and the small industrial estate. This gives improved access to both the Showground and the industrial estate.
- 6. Directing traffic along the Old Pacific Highway improves vehicle traffic to the commercial development along the Old Pacific Highway.
- 7. That section of the road from Manns Road to the intersection of Glennie Street and the Old Pacific Highway involving the crossing of Narara Creek and the railway line is the same route as the proposed east west bypass.
- 8. Cost of major infrastructure can be shared with two major projects of east west bypass and north south bypass diverting traffic around Gosford City Centre.

# Gosford to Somersby industrial Estate and Kariong (Loop Service)




